Rather than amending the existing training materials and re-release once more, Lantra asks that you use statement below in conjunction with the current Instructor guidance document for both 12B LTMO and 12A TMF.

On the next revision of those training materials the Instructor Guidance documents will be updated to include this statement.

NHSS Rule on retaining operative status

At the last NHSS 12AB committee meeting it was agreed that if an LTMO or TMF learner has failed their respective refresher course but actually scored 75% or above on the multiple-choice questions they would be able to retain their 12AB Operative status.

The current training materials (including the V6 TMF recently issued in December 2020) does not reflect that option nor do the test paper front covers.

Instructors for the 12B LTMO exam will be able to mark the exam papers and identify Learners that fall into this category. 12A TMF exam results will be marked externally and the results will be informed to the Provider for confirmation.
