



Subject: NEW TSCO Course

Date: April 2021

Dear Training Providers and Industry partners,

The technical working group on behalf of the NHSS 12ABCD Committee have updated the TSCO training package in line with the latest industry standards and practices. This redevelopment and upgrade will increase the course duration to two days to cover all new content. This will replace the existing material on 1st September 2021.

All currently approved TSCO Instructors will be required to attend a one-day standard setting event prior to delivering the new training package. Lantra will provide further details about the TSCO Instructor standard setting events shortly to the relevant NHSS 12 Training Providers.
