- NPSBS Refresher course is 1 day and includes exam papers for each system

- If the Learner held a "Skilled Worker" or higher skill level which has expired and want to regain the skill, if they are within 2 years of that expiry date then they do not need to re-sit the TTMBC course.
- "Trainee" skills do not have a grace period. On expiry, the Learner must reapply from the start.
- Where the Learner has a valid assessment skill, training courses update the assessment expiry from the date of the course.

- If the Learner held a "Skilled Worker" or higher skill level which has expired and want to regain the skill, if they are within 2 years of that expiry date then they do not need to re-sit the TTMBC course.
- "Trainee" skills do not have a grace period. On expiry, the Learner must reapply from the start.
- Fully assessed 12C Supervisors are automatically granted IPV Hard Shoulder and Live Lanes Status

- If the "Labourer" skill is valid the Learner can undertake the Gate Person test and this will renew the "Labourer" skill.
- If the skill has expired, but within 6 months of the expiry date the Learner is eligible to re-sit the training course.
- If the Learner has let their skill expire longer than 6 months, they must reapply from the start.
- Once the TTMBC expires, Learners are not permitted to work as a Trainee for 12AB, 12C or 12D. The Gate Person skill doesn't permit you to work as a Trainee TTM operative.
