

Traffic Safety and Control Officers (TSCO)

Please note the following:

All applicants must have successfully passed the NHSS 12A Foreman Course and hold an approved Lantra Awards 12A Foreman Course certificate or a 12A Foreman category on their card. NB It is acceptable to apply if you hold a 12B LTMO card, if you have successfully completed a 12A Foreman course.

The TSCO category will indicate that the applicant has completed and passed the 12A Foreman course as a requirement to operate as a Traffic Safety and Control Officer **only**. The cardholder is **not** a qualified Operative or Foreman unless stated on their card.

For those wishing to qualify as a TSCO or be reaccredited, must meet the following criteria:

- Passed the 12A Foreman training course (**if you are a certificate holder only and not a Foreman or LTMO skills card holder then a TSCO card must be applied for within two years of achieving the Foreman course**)
- Passed the Traffic Safety & Control Officer training course (**first time applicants must apply within two years of achieving the TSCO course**)
- Have an appropriate in date first aid course (**must include the First Aid at Work Regulations 1981**)
- Have an valid Health & Safety Course or Qualification; this may be:
 - IOSH – Managing Safely – **with date of issue no longer than 5 years**
 - IOSH - Directing Safely – **with date of issue no longer than 5 years**
 - CITB - Site Management Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS)
 - CITB – Site Supervisors Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS)
 - NeBOSH – General Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health
 - NeBOSH – Certificate in Construction Health and Safety
 - NeBOSH – International general certificate in Occupational Safety and Health
 - NeBOSH – National Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health
 - NeBOSH – International Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health

As detailed in the Specification for Highway Works the above requirements became mandatory on the 1st April 2009.

Important Note – TSCO Category Expiry and Renewal Timescales:

A renewed TSCO category expiry date should correlate with your 12A Foreman category expiry date unless you are a 12A Foreman certificate holder.

If your TSCO category expires by more than six months you will be required to recomplete the TSCO course, in addition to standard requirements, before a new TSCO category can be applied for, unless you are a current 12A Foreman category holder.
