## **News Update: TTMBC Rule clarification**

Lantra would like to bring your attention to a new rule of combination concerning the Temporary Traffic Management Basic Course (TTMBC) which is active with immediate effect.

In cases where a Learner has achieved a minimum of skilled worker level qualification and this skill has expired and exceeded the grace period, the Learner has exactly 2 years from the expiry date where they are not required to undertake the TTMBC course to reactivate their skills.

For example:

<b>Governing rule</b>	<b>TTMBC</b>	<b>Training</b>	<b>Assessment</b>
<b>Learners' skill has expired, but, within grace period</b>		✓	
<b>Learners' skill and grace period expired, within 2 years of expired skill date (new rule)</b>		✓	✓
<b>Learners' skill and grace period expired, over 2 years of expired date</b>	✓	✓	✓

\*Rule still applies for skilled work or supervisor CSCS levelled qualifications which do not require practical assessment to achieve, e.g. 12D M1, M6, M7

The new rule will help learners looking to reactive their expiry skills within the stated time period
